

## Cochran School of Nursing Medical Library Guide to Mosby's Nursing Consult

### Accessing Mosby's Nursing Consult (MNC)

Go to the Cochran School of Nursing home page: <http://www.cochranschoolofnursing.us>

Under the "Library" tab, click "Mosby's Nursing Consult". The homepage will open and you will be able to create a personal account. (To enable remote access from home, the username and password must be created while on the St. John's Riverside Hospital/Cochran School of Nursing campus).

### **How to create a personal account**

At the right-hand side of the homepage, click on Login/Register, A box will open with the option to login or register for a personal account.

### **MNC Homepage**

If you click on the "About MNC" tab on the homepage, you will find the "Explore Features" which will guide you on the specific areas available in the database including the following:

#### **Books**

You can search the entire book collection for a topic by entering your term in the search box on the left-hand side of the homepage and selecting "Books" from the drop-down menu then entering your term e.g. "diabetes". You can also browse the list of books by choosing "Reference" from the tabs at the top; choose a book from the list. You can also search within the book using the search box immediately below the title of the book.

#### **Journals**

Journals can be searched the same way as books, either by the whole collection or by individual title

#### **Patient Education Clinical Reference Tool**

Select Patient Education information by clicking on the tab on the homepage. Search by topic or condition in the search box on the left-hand side of the page or in the "quick find" box. Select your patient handout from the results by checking the box. To print the handout, select "print selected handouts" from the right-hand side of the page. A new window will open which allows you to personalize the handout with the patient's information.
