

Qualitative interviews using purposive sampling by children 7 to 12 years of age were conducted during 2010 and 2011. The interview schedule to understand the experience, feelings and daily experiences with the management of diabetes. Results indicated that the children in a 100% reported activities and difficulties that may interfere with their ability to manage diabetes. These factors included: diabetes diagnosis, diagnosis, low social knowledge, early disease diagnosis, anxiety, rejection, and shame. Findings suggest that strong patient teaching at the time of diagnosis and follow-up, social, educational, spiritual and only the physical aspects of the disease should require monitoring, medical administration, and exercise management, but also require emotional and psychosocial needs, and discuss strategies that will promote positive coping in children face with the complexities of growing up with diabetes.

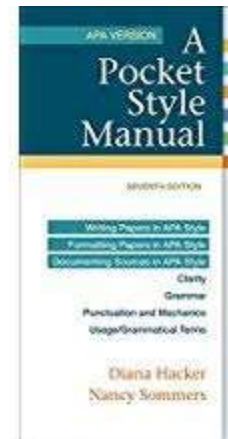
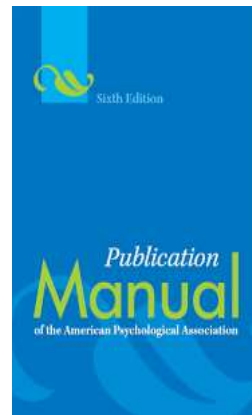
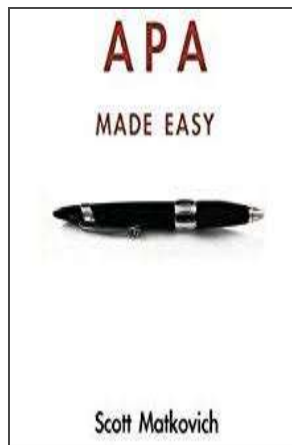
